Feb. 21 - Love your Buddhist neighbor (Sharon Seeberger) Buddhism: A Sponge that Absorbs Many Popular Religions and Culture. Why are there so many forms of Buddhism? Why does the western Zen Buddhism look so different than the spirit driven form of Thailand? Learn how Buddha's original teaching has changed and evolved over the years in varying ways in different cultures. Find out how you can discern examples of Buddhism in conversations with your friends as well as the people you meet while traveling the world. Discover commonalities on which to build relationships and lead people into discovering the grace that Jesus only offers.

Feb. 28 - Love your Hindu neighbor (John Becker). 14% of the world's population consider themselves Hindus - that's 800Million people. Is Hinduism a religion, philosophy or culture? Where do most Hindus live? Come learn the basics of Hinduism and its people. Taste some spicy vegetarian food and enjoy sweet chai. John will present a global and local outlook on Hindus and encourage us to take an active part in living out the Good News of Jesus to our Hindu neighbors both near and far. There will be plenty of stories of life in a Hindu community.

March 13-Healing & restoration in Sexual Identity (Sarah Allis Yang). In 1994, on the brink of killing herself after years in sexual identity confusion, God changed Sarah's life in a supernatural encounter. Since that life-changing moment, she has undergone a dramatic transformation after she discovered her true identity, God's design for sexuality, and what true love is really all about.
