BRIEF HISTORY & OVERVIEW

Peninsula Covenant Church (PCC) is a local church with a rich and intriguing history. PCC is emerging from the effects of the pandemic and looking to the future. Today, PCC celebrates almost seven decades of ministry serving the Silicon Valley in the greater San Francisco Bay Area. Our deep roots in the Redwood City area are evidenced by the multi-generational families who make up this body of devoted believers. PCC is affiliated with the Evangelical Covenant Church (ECC) denomination, and is part of the Pacific Southwest Conference. Being in the ECC remains a valuable connection point that connects PCC to its deeper story.



WORSHIP APPROACH

PCC currently has one in-person worship gathering each week that integrates elements of traditional and contemporary styles. This is a recent change that allows PCC the greatest opportunity to be an intergenerational church and makes the best use of staff and volunteer time/resources. We are poised to add a second, same-style gathering at the appropriate time.

PCC's Sunday gatherings are primarily focused on discipling believers through musical worship and preaching. PCC simultaneously strives to create a welcoming culture for all who attend, clear pathways for all who want to further engage and connect to the PCC community, and teaching that is seeker-sensible.

PCC is committed to having worship leaders on the platform who reflect the current generational and ethnic/racial diversity of our congregation, as we strive to embrace the diversity of our larger community.

PCC also has a robust online presence which allows for those online to engage through a live-stream.









ATTENDANCE

Although the state of the pandemic has caused PCC to be in a time of transition and ever-changing attendance, the most recent data shows that approximately 300+ people attend in-person and an additional 150+ people attend online. On Easter Sunday 2022, 873 people attended our two worship gatherings in person. Approximately 40% are involved in Life Groups, and approximately 5-10% have been a Christian for 5 years or less.

DEMOGRAPHICS

We are proud of our heritage of four generations of families worshiping, serving, and growing together. PCC's ethnic diversity is: 77% White, 12% Asian American & Pacific Islander, 10% Latinx/Hispanic, and 1% African American. In addition, our community includes every age and life stage. We value the ethnic and cultural mosaic that is reflected in Revelations 7:9 and strive to uphold this in the ways we approach ministry within and outside of the church.



CAMPUS

God has generously blessed PCC with a gorgeous 14.8-acre park-like campus in the foothills overlooking the Silicon Valley. The campus has been built out slowly and strategically over the decades, including an original mid-century designed classroom space, offices, and a remarkable wood and glass sanctuary that has state-of-the-art sound system and video streaming capabilities. The views throughout the campus are stunning. Redwood trees, California oaks, and a beautiful creek and canyon provide backdrops to multiple buildings, along with an expansive 55' high footbridge connecting the Center campus with the Church campus over the canyon and creek. We have four residences on our campus and four residences off-campus that are managed by our Aslan Housing Foundation and provide affordable housing to a portion of our church staff.







CHURCH MINISTRIES

PCC adults grow in their walk with Jesus through participating in Life Groups, adult Bible studies on Sunday mornings, Growth Groups (short-term studies), Church events, and spiritual growth opportunities/resources. Other ministry opportunities include Stephen Ministry, Rooted discipleship classes, Men's Ministry, Women's Ministry, and Do Justice, Love Mercy Ministry.

PCC children, students, and families have historically been a strength and priority for us. We are in transition with family and student ministry leadership due to recent staff departures. Our programs include Sunday School for children, Midweek for 3rd & 4th graders, Middle School (5th-8th), High School, and Young Adults.

PCC is known for its love for and service to the Redwood City community and beyond. We have a history of having an entrepreneurial approach to ministry which has allowed us to create many innovative programs.

PCC also partners with local non-profit organizations in a variety of areas; feeding the unhoused, children's literacy, supporting refugees, PE+ which provides PE instruction in the local schools, and organizing school beautification projects. We use our campus facilities for a variety of parachurch and community ministries such as Bible Study Fellowship, Street Life Ministries, and Generations United. We also share our campus with a Spanish-speaking Covenant congregation, Comunidad Familiar Cristiana.

PCC supports over 30 different national and international ministries including organizations and individual missionaries serving in Africa, Asia, Europe, and Latin America.

MINISTRIES: FEE-BASED

PCC operates three fee-based ministries that serve the greater community: Preschool, Community Center, and School Age Child Care (SACC). In the 1960s, PCC saw the need and started PCC Preschool that still serves the local community. In the 1970s, an adjacent swim, tennis, and fitness facility, now called Peninsula Community Center was acquired and expanded. The Center provides a robust sports ministry, fitness and aquatics program, as well as space for Sunday morning and mid-week gatherings. Currently, membership at the Center is approximately 850 families (2100 people total). In the 1990s, PCC responded to the need for after school care in the Redwood City community and started the School Age Childcare program at PCC, now known as PCC SACC, which also offers Summer Camps. The families these ministries serve are largely unchurched but are embraced as part of the larger PCC Community.







GOVERNANCE

PCC is a congregational-led, pastor/staff-driven church. The Leadership Team (Council), elected by our 400+ stakeholders, is composed of four officers (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer), representatives of our six principal ministries (Adult Ministries, Community Center, Missions, Preschool and School Aged Child Care, Students and Families, and Worship) and the Lead Pastor. The Leadership Team is responsible for the high-level oversight of the spiritual, administrative, and fiscal matters of the Church in close collaboration with staff and ministry leaders.

FINANCIALS

PCC's proposed total budget of \$6.8M for the June 2022 - May 2023 fiscal year is funded through church expected giving of \$3M and fee-based ministries revenues (Community Center, Preschool, and School Aged Child Care) totaling \$3.8M. Apart from PCC's fee-based ministries, Family Ministries (infants through young adults), Worship, Adult Ministries and Missions will receive the most funding resources in the next fiscal year.





REDWOOD CITY AND THE PENINSULA

The city of Redwood City is a San Francisco Bay Area community located in the heart of Silicon Valley, the technology-rich region extending from the San Francisco Peninsula to the foothills of the Santa Cruz Mountains. Peninsula Covenant Church is located 25 minutes from both San Francisco and San Jose, and is a beautiful 10-minute drive from the Stanford University campus, and a 25-minute drive to the Pacific Ocean.

Redwood City is the third largest city in the County of San Mateo, with 84,292 residents. The city enjoys an average of 255 sunny days a year, which it boasts via the city slogan: "Climate Best by Government Test." Redwood City has become known as a start-up hub for technology and other industries. The vibrant downtown area is an entertainment destination of the San Francisco Peninsula offering residents, visitors, and businesses a unique retail, entertainment, and restaurant experience.

Redwood City is a multi-generational and multi-racial community, with a majority of its residents from non-white backgrounds. It is also an area of socio-economic diversity. To learn more about this vibrant, diverse city, visit: Redwood City.

The price of an average mid-tier home in Redwood City is \$2M. The high cost of living is a challenge that PCC is addressing proactively. <u>Aslan Housing Foundation</u>, mentioned previously, was created by lay leaders at PCC in an effort to provide affordable housing for staff and actively seeks to provide housing solutions. PCC and Aslan have affordable homes under active management, and have a clear criterion and a system of awarding pastoral housing at PCC.

The Lead Pastor is the leader of Peninsula Covenant Church to whom the congregation, Leadership Team, ministry teams, and staff members look for both spiritual and professional direction, guidance, and vision. The Lead Pastor is our preacher and teacher, spiritual leader, vision-caster, congregational shepherd, and guide for all ministries of PCC.

- Foster an outreach culture that seeks to share the love of Jesus and serve both our local and international communities.

- Establish and model the standards of godly church leadership including worship attendance, small group participation, and a generous lifestyle that includes serving that is aligned with calling and giftedness.
