

## We Three Kings — Mark Tumney

## **READ MATTHEW 2:1-12**

- **1. Reflecting on the Magi's Journey:** What stands out to you about the Magi's willingness to leave their homes and follow the star? How does their journey inspire your own pursuit of Jesus?
- 2. Hospitality Lessons from Mary: Imagine being in Mary's position when the Magi arrived. How do you think you would have reacted? What can this teach us about welcoming those who are different from us?
- **3. Encountering Outsiders:** Have you ever felt like an outsider in a church or other community? What helped (or could have helped) you feel included?
- **4.** The Role of Creation and Scripture: The star led the Magi to seek Jesus, but Scripture directed them to Him. How would you describe the difference between how God uses Scripture versus creation.
- **5. Radical Hospitality vs. Compromise:** Mark encouraged us to extend radical hospitality without compromising Scripture. How can we balance these two tension points in our own lives and in our church?

6. Barriers to Welcoming Others: What attitudes or fears might prevent us from welcoming people who don't look, think, or act like us? How can we address these barriers?

**7. Remembering Our Own Journey:** Reflect on the statement, "At one point, every one of us were the Magi." How does remembering our own journey to Jesus help us extend grace to others?

**8.** A Changed Path: The Magi went home by another route after meeting Jesus. How has encountering Jesus changed the direction of your life?

**9. Personal Invitations:** The Magi were drawn by a star, a unique sign for them. What unique ways might God be using you to draw others to Him?

**10. Belonging Before Believing:** The sermon emphasized that people should feel they belong before they believe. How can we make this a reality in our small group and our church?
