1.	Imagine the Shepherds: What emotions or thoughts would you experience if you
	were in the shepherds' shoes, invited to meet the Messiah unexpectedly?

- 2. **Personal Connection:** Can you share a time when you felt unworthy or out of place but were still invited to something meaningful? How did it make you feel?
- **3. God's Invitation:** How does the idea that "God meets us in our mess" challenge or encourage you in your current season of life?
- **4. Unexpected Choices:** Why do you think God chose the shepherds—lowly and overlooked—as the first to meet Jesus? How does that impact your understanding of God's character?
- **5. Good News for All:** The angel's message was "good news for all people." Who do you think needs to hear this good news in your community, and how can you share it?

6.	<b>Come as You Are:</b> What barriers—internal or external—make it hard for you to "come as you are" to God? How can you overcome them?
7.	<b>Transformation:</b> The shepherds returned to their fields but were transformed by their encounter with Jesus. Have you ever experienced a moment or event that changed how you viewed life or faith?
8.	<b>Peace in the Mess:</b> The sermon speaks of peace that comes from knowing God is with us. Where do you need that kind of peace in your life right now?
9.	<b>Response to the Invitation:</b> The shepherds responded immediately to the angel's message. What might it look like for you to respond to God's invitation today, either for the first time or in a deeper way?
10.	<b>Sharing the News:</b> The shepherds spread the word about Jesus after meeting Him. What holds you back from sharing your faith? How can you take one step forward in sharing the good news?
