1.	Read Nehemiah 6:1–4.  What stands out to you about Nehemiah's response to the repeated invitations to meet? Why do you think he refused—what was at stake?
2.	Nehemiah said, "I am doing a great work and I cannot come down." What is a "great work" God has called you to in this season of your life?
3.	The pressure Nehemiah faced wasn't always obvious.  What subtle or "reasonable-sounding" distractions pull you away from God's call?
4.	Nehemiah prayed, "Now strengthen my hands." What would it look like for you to depend on God this week instead of pushing through on your own?

5.	Think about the name Shemaiah—"The Lord hears." How can we discern whether a spiritual voice is truly from God? What has helped you grow in spiritual discernment?
6.	In the sermon, we talked about Ulysses tying himself to the mast. What practices or relationships in your life help "anchor" you to faith when temptations or discouragement come?
7.	Read Nehemiah 6:15–16.  What impact did Nehemiah's perseverance have on the people around him?  How might your own faithfulness encourage someone else?
8.	"Someone stayed on the wall for you."  How does remembering Jesus' faithfulness on the cross encourage you to stay faithful today?
9.	What's one way we as a group can help each other stay focused on Jesus this week?
10.	Take a moment to pray for one another.  Who in your group might need to hear, "Stay on the wall"? Encourage and pray for one another by name.
