Gather

These questions help build connections with others as you share personal experiences.

- When you hear the word “**generosity**,” what’s one experience—positive or difficult—that comes to mind?

Grow

These questions guide your group through scripture from Sunday’s Sermon. Sharing observations to lead to greater understanding of scripture and God’s work in our lives.

Read Psalm 24:1

“The earth is the Lord’s, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it.”

- What does this verse tell us about ownership versus stewardship?
- How does believing that everything belongs to God reshape the way we think about generosity?

Read Matthew 10:1, 5–8

- Why do you think Jesus was specific about who the disciples were sent to first?
- Who might be the “lost sheep” in our own community today?
- What do Jesus’ instructions (healing, restoring, delivering) reveal about the heart of God’s kingdom?

Read Matthew 10:8b–10

- Why does Jesus connect receiving from God with giving to others?
- What does this passage teach us about trusting God as our provider?

Matthew 6:19–21

- How does Jesus challenge us to examine why we give, not just how we give?
- What earthly treasures most compete for our trust or security?

Give / Go

These questions help us apply the sermon take-aways to how we will give back to God and go share what we've learned through application and life change.

- How does the idea of **Re:Gifting**—giving from what God has already given—change your view of generosity?
- What is one faithful step God may be inviting you to take this week—financially, relationally, or spiritually—to Re:Gift what He's entrusted to you?

Prayer

Read together **Matthew 10:8b** — “**Freely you have received; freely give.**”

- Thank God for what He has freely given each of you.
- Ask God to help you trust Him as your provider.
- Pray for the people God wants to bless **through** your generosity.
