Our Home: Psalm 90:1-2 — Rachel Taylor

Gather

These questions help build connection and ease into the theme of "home."

1. When you think of the word home, what comes to mind? What has most shaped your sense of home over the years?
2. Have you ever experienced a season where "home" felt uncertain or changing? What was that like for you?

Grow

These questions guide deeper engagement with Scripture and the sermon themes.

Primary Passage: Psalm 90:1-2

"Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations..."

1. **What stands out to you in Psalm 90:1-2 about how God is described?**
2. **What does it mean that God is our "dwelling place" before creation itself?**
3. **The sermon described a "nesting" image (cave → mountain → earth → God).**
 - How does this help you understand the difference between temporary security and ultimate security?
4. **Throughout Scripture (Eden, tabernacle, temple, Jesus, Holy Spirit, new creation)**
 - How do we see God's desire to dwell with His people?
 - Which part of that story resonates most with you right now?
5. **Read Hebrews 4:9-11**
 - What do you think it means to "make every effort to enter that rest"?
 - How is effort different from earning in your relationship with God?
6. **Romans 8:15 & Ephesians 1:5**
 - What does it mean to you personally to be "adopted" into God's family?
 - Why do you think trust in God as "home" often takes time to grow?

Give / Go

These questions help move toward application and life change.

1. Where are you most tempted to find your sense of security or belonging *apart from God* (home, career, relationships, finances, etc.)?
2. What is one intentional step you can take this week to “make your home” in God? (Examples: setting aside daily prayer time, trying a simple fixed-hour pause, engaging Scripture regularly, or reconnecting with Christian community)

Prayer

Direction for Prayer:

Spend time inviting God to become your true “dwelling place.” Offer Him the areas where you feel unstable, anxious, or disconnected, and ask Him to deepen your sense of belonging in His presence.

You may pray this Scripture together:

“Lord, you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations.” — Psalm 90:1

Group Prayer Question:

How can we be praying for one another as we seek to find our security and home in God this week?
